

SONG: WHERE IS MONKEY?

Procedure: The children cut out the finger puppets and the teacher uses TPR to instruct them to put the different animals on their fingers ('Put the monkey on your left thumb', 'Put the lion on your right forefinger,' etc).

They hide their left hand behind their back and start singing the song by showing the different animals when they are called out.

Song (to be sung to the tune of *Frère Jacques*):

Where is Monkey, Where is Monkey? (Children wiggle their right thumb, which will have another animal puppet on it)

Here I am, here I am (wiggle left thumb with the monkey on it)

How are you today, sir? (join fingers, 'greeting' each other)

Very well, I thank you. (as above)

Run away, run away. (hide left hand first and then right one).

Where is Lion, Where is Lion? (Children wiggle right forefinger, etc)

Where is Rabbit, Where is Rabbit?.....

Where is Mouse, Where is Zebra?.....

Where is Giraffe, Where is Giraffe?.....

Where are the animals, where are the animals?

Here we are, here we are. (show and wiggle all fingers)

How are you today, sirs? (clap hands)

Very well, we thank you. (clap hands)

Run away, run away. (hide left hand first and then right one).

This song can be adapted to any topic and be sung with puppets related to the lesson plan.
